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- Text
 - 11 εἴτε οὖν ἐγὼ εἴτε ἐκεῖνοι, οὕτως κηρύσσομεν καὶ οὕτως ἐπιστεύσατε.
- Translation
 - 11 Therefore, whether I (preach) or they (preach), we preach in this manner and you believed in this manner.

11 εἴτε οὖν ἐγὼ εἴτε ἐκεῖνοι, οὗτως
κηρύσσομεν καὶ οὗτως ἐπιστεύσατε.

- εἴτε...εἴτε - cond. conj. Frequently together as an idiom: "whether...or; if...or."
- ...οὖν - inferential conj. [W673]
- ἐγὼ... - nom. subj. of an elided κηρύσσω. The implied subj. of the verb that follows, κηρύσσομεν, along with ἐκεῖνοι.
- ἐκεῖνοι, - nom. subj. of an elided κηρύσσουσι. Sometimes the dem. pronoun is used as a person pronoun [W328-29]. The implied subj. of the verb that follows, κηρύσσομεν, along with ἐγὼ.

11 εἴτε οὖν ἐγὼ εἴτε ἐκεῖνοι, οὗτως
κηρύσσομεν καὶ οὗτως ἐπιστεύσατε.

- οὗτως - adv. "referring to what precedes, *in this manner, thus, so*" (BDAG 1.b).
- κηρύσσομεν - subj. and main verb [pres-act-ind-1-p-κηρύσσω]. Customary (habitual/general) use of the present tense [W521-22].
- καὶ - connective conj.
- οὗτως - adv. "referring to what precedes, *in this manner, thus, so*" (BDAG 1.b).
- ἐπιστεύσατε. - subj. and main verb [aor-act-ind-2-p-πιστεύω].

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
